



Daniels Mac/PC FTP Upload Instructions using Cyberduck

Overview

This document provides step-by-step instructions on uploading files to the Daniels FTP Site, using an Apple Mac or PC and the Cyberduck FTP client program.

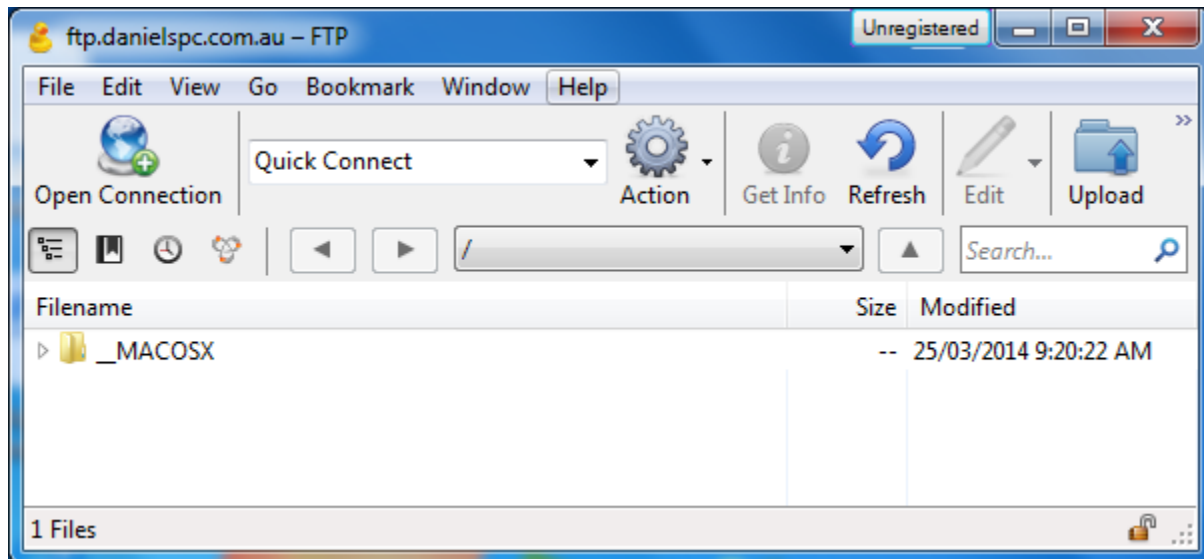
Although, Cyberduck is being used in this case, the settings can be applied to any available FTP client program and used in a similar fashion, whether on Mac or Windows based computers.

Instructions

1. Download and install Cyberduck from <http://cyberduck.ch/> or the Mac Apple Store <http://itunes.apple.com/us/app/cyberduck/id409222199?mt=12&ls=1>.
2. Open Cyberduck and from the application click the **Open Connection** button.
3. Enter the settings shown in the screenshot below, using the same username **daniels** and **92046800**, as the password.
